

Driving Range Policy

The driving range, short game area and putting green at Cottonwood are restricted to Cottonwood and Palo Verde homeowners and their guests, Annual Golf Members and their guests, 25 Play Card holders and their guests, and Daily Green fee players.

1. At no time should any member or guest enter the driving range past the white markers, or forward of the practice bunker. If any item needs to be retrieved from the range, please consult with the Cottonwood Pro Shop.
2. The members and guests are reminded that when using the practice facilities extreme caution should be taken on the actual driving range and range practice bunker at all times.
3. Range keys, range key refills and tokens are only available at Cottonwood Pro Shop.
4. The range balls and baskets should never be removed from the practice facilities at any time.
5. All children should be escorted by an adult and should be watched carefully on all practice facilities at all times.
6. Only official Cottonwood range balls should be used on the driving range and driving range bunker.
7. The driving range will be closed on each ball retrieval day from 3:00p.m.-3:30p.m. for hand retrieval of range balls. Please show consideration for the driving range attendants when clearing and picking the range.
8. Sun Lakes Homeowner's Association will not be held responsible for any violations of the driving range policy. Violating driving range policies will result in loss of privileges to the practice facilities.
