

Pickleball

There are seven pickleball courts at Cottonwood for Cottonwood Palo Verde homeowners, guests, renters and associate members. The courts have lights for night time play.

The Sun Lakes Pickleball Club Cottonwood (SLPCC) members are granted exclusive use of the courts Monday thru Friday as listed below.

Summer hours: May 1 - September 30, 7:00 AM - 11:00 AM

Winter hours: October 1 - April 30, 8:00 AM – 2:00 PM

The SLPC also has tournaments throughout the year when the courts will be unavailable for play.

The remaining time, called open play time, is available to all Cottonwood Palo Verde homeowners, guests, renters and associate members. These times are as follows.

Summer hours: May 1 - September 30
 Monday to Friday, 11:00 AM - 9:00 PM
 Saturday and Sunday, 7:00 AM - 9:00 PM

Winter hours: October 1 - April 30
 Monday to Friday, 2:00 PM to 9:00 PM
 Saturday and Sunday, 7:00 AM to 9:00 PM

CWPV Residents may bring guests to play pickleball **only** during HOA open play times, on a one-to-one basis; that is, one CWPV homeowner must be present for each non-CWPV homeowner guest on the court.

HOA open time players desiring a court must sign up on the chalkboard with their name, the number of players in their group, and start time. If all the courts are in use, reservations for a court may be made in the next available timeslot. Once a court has been reserved, one player from the group must stay in the sign-up area until their reserved time has been reached.

Playing time is limited to one hour, starting on the hour. Groups playing prior to a previously scheduled event must leave the court at the start of the event unless there is no one else signed up.

All pickleball players using the courts must comply with the HOA dress code and footwear code. Shirts and non-marking shoes, tennis or court shoes, must be worn at all times. Tank tops, swimwear, midriff exposing tops, cutoffs, and sandals are not considered proper attire.

The SLPCC membership, by HOA policy, is limited to thirty-five non-CWPV residents during any calendar year. Residents of Sun Lakes Country Club, IronOaks, and Renaissance may purchase an annual membership, with approval of the Club's president, at the Recreation department at a set rate by the HOA. The rate set by the HOA may vary, depending upon the existence of reciprocal agreements.
