What is the purpose of the yellow stakes on edges of the Fairways?!?!

Golf Maintenance has placed yellow stakes at the edges of the fairways to indicate where golf carts should return to the cart path. They are placed in use to protect the playing areas around the green and to reduce traffic damage within 50 yards of the green.





You will see Red-White-Blue dots on the edges of the fairway as well. These are the locations where the yellow stakes get placed on a rotational basis during the week. For example, this week all the yellow stakes are on the RED location. Next week, they will be in the WHITE position and the following week they will be placed in the BLUE position. This is done to rotate the directed exit position from week-to-week so to reduce wear patterns at the stake itself.







As golfers, we all understand that golf is a game of etiquette.... Raking bunkers, fixing ball marks, sanding divots... these are all things golfers do to be respectful of the golf course and the field of golfers. Please do your part to make the course better for your friends, fellow Members, guests, and the entire golfing community. Please do not drive past these stakes as you make your way to the green surround area.
